Established in April 2016, the plaza serves as a vibrant new landmark, bringing people together through arts and culture.


With a wide range of events and initiatives, it provides opportunities to experience both local and international culture.



Designed primarily for music, this hall offers outstanding acoustics and a rich, immersive sound experience. Its four-tiered seating arrangement and spacious design enhance the depth and clarity of every performance. The hall is equipped with extensive stage facilities, including an orchestra pit and a temporary hanamichi (runway stage), making it suitable not only for classical concerts but also for operas, musicals, kabuki performances, and MICE events. With the farthest seat just 30 meters from the stage, the hall provides an intimate connection between performers and the audience. The seats, designed for comfort, feature a generous width of 54 cm, ensuring a relaxed and enjoyable experience.

A Hall with Extensive Stage Facilities. This versatile hall is ideal for a wide range of performances, including theater, dance, concerts, lectures, and ceremonies. It features a traditional Noh stage (a traditional Japanese stage) with waki-kensho(side stage areas), allowing for authentic Noh performances. Additionally, masuseki (Box Seats) are available on both sides of the first-floor seating area, enhancing the viewing experience.

The small hall offers a highly adaptable space with adjustable flooring to accommodate various layouts.

By removing the seating, the entire area can be converted into a flat stage, making it suitable for a variety of performances. It can function as a black box theater for intimate productions or open up to offer a scenic view of Meiji Street.

This multi-purpose space is ideal for theater, dance, music performances, rehearsals, and seminars.



The space can also be divided into three sections, providing even greater adaptability for different events.




The large, medium, and small meeting rooms can each be divided into three sections, allowing for flexible space arrangements to suit different needs.





A dignified Japanese room for celebrating tradition Japanese Room "CHOSEI"

Each of the three kyoma (traditional Japanese tatami rooms) are the size of eight tatami mats (12.4 meters squared) and are equipped with a small tea stove that allows for charcoal or gas. These rooms are ideal for tea ceremonies, practice sessions, and gatherings. With a tea preparation area, kitchen, and garden path, the space can be expanded into a large 30-tatami-mat(37.2 meters squared) hall by removing the sliding doors, making it perfect for various traditional Japanese cultural events. It can also be used for workshops featuring low tables.




